- 4. Player will exit and return to the waiting area and prep for hitting please no swinging bats outside the batting cage.
- 5. One at a time, player will swing at five pitches from a volunteer.
- 6. Once hitting is complete player will exit to parent waiting area.
- 7. Players wanting to be a Pitcher/Catcher must stay for Pitching/Catching Evaluations All other players may leave after their hitting evaluation.
