## Process - See attached map for reference.

1. All Players Check-In at Snack Bar and Receive their Number.
2. Players and their parents are free to use Field #1 for stretching, warming up, playing catch, etc. Coaches may roam Field #1 to watch warmups and evaluate players' catching abilities.
3. When announced, players will line up at 3rd base dugout of Field #3. Players will need to have their glove<sup>1</sup> with them.
4. One at a time, player will take two grounders at 3rd and throw to 1st, then shift to 2nd and take two grounders and throw to 1st.
5. Player will exit Field #3 through the 1st base dugout. Player will give their glove to their parent and receive their bat and batting helmet from their parent. Player will then line up at the 3rd base dugout of Field #4 to wait for the hitting and running evaluation.
6. One at a time, player will swing at five soft-toss pitches from a volunteer.<sup>2</sup> After swinging on the fifth pitch, player will drop bat and run to 1st base.
7. Player will retrieve bat and exit Field #4 through the 1st base dugout.
8. Players wanting to be a pitcher must stay for Pitching Evaluations on Field #2. All other players may leave after their hitting evaluation.

**REMEMBER - WE'RE HERE FOR FUN.** Most of our 8U and 10U players won't be able to throw a ball from third to first (or even second to first). A lot of players will be lucky to hit 2 or 3 of the soft-toss pitches. A lot of the kids will be nervous and that's okay. :-)

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<sup>1</sup> Loaner gloves, bats, and batting helmets will be available.

<sup>2</sup> Volunteer has discretion to throw up to 2 additional pitches for bad throws.
