

## West Sacramento Girls Softball COVID-19 Policy



**Mask Use:** Consistent with current regulations, policies, and recommendations of the California Department of Public Health and Yolo County, West Sacramento Girls Softball is not requiring masks for practices, gameplay, being in the dugout, or for working in the snack bar. Individuals who want to wear masks are encouraged to do so, but wearing a mask is not required for participation in any West Sacramento Girls Softball activities.

**Quarantine and Exposure Policy:** Regarding quarantining of players, coaches, and volunteers who have COVID-19 or are exposed to someone with COVID-19, the policy of West Sacramento Girls Softball mirrors the then-current policy of Washington Unified School District ("WUSD")<sup>1</sup>. Any updates to the WUSD COVID-19 policies for quarantine and exposure will be considered automatic updates of the West Sacramento Girls Softball COVID-19 policies.
